



Since 2012, we have been adding the “A” (Art) into STEM (*Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math*). To foster development of these skills, the National Education Association (NEA) has incorporated the arts into STEM emphasizing “STEAM” education that unleashes creativity and promotes innovation. Our outreach events have served approximately 70,000 youth in Fauquier, Fairfax, Prince William, Florida & Washington DC. In January, 2016, we became an official collaborative partner with The Boys & Girls Club of Fauquier serving 190 children in our after school & summer program at the Club. Other community collaborative partners are Habitat for Humanity, Warrenton Restore, Allegro Community School & Families 4 Fauquier.
