Camp Fees

- Basic Camp Fee \$200 per camp
- Transportation from Warrenton \$45 per week per camper (optional)
- Before and after Care \$5 per hour by the half hour (optional)
- Supply Fee \$25 for Lego and Chef Camps

How to Register for Camp

You can now register and pay online on our website. Just fill out the online form and hit submit. Then click the PayPal button to pay the registration deposit. You can also print out a paper registration form, fill it out and either mail it in or bring it by the school along with the deposit fee(s).

The registration deposit is \$50 for the first camp and \$25 for each additional camp for which you register. Registration deposits are non-refundable. Registration fees count towards the camp fee. The balance is due the Friday before the first day of camp.

Required Documents

Students who are not enrolled at Fresta Valley Christian School during the school year, need to supply the following documents prior to the start of the camp for which they are registered:

- 1. Birth Certificate** : (A certified copy must be presented by a parent or legal guardian in person on or before the first day of camp.)
- 2. Immunization Record or Exemption Form** (This may be faxed in by your doctor if desired.)

Transportation From Warrenton

Bus transportation is available from the Sears parking lot in Warrenton for \$45 per week. Pick up is at 8:30 am and drop off is 3:30 pm. Please indicate on the registration form if you desire bus service.

Before and After Care

Before and after care are offered at a cost of \$5 per hour. Pre-arrangements must be made for this service. Before care hours are from 7 am – 9 am. After Care hours are from 3 pm – 5 pm. Please indicate on the registration form if you desire before and after care.

Get a Discount

Campers who register for six or more weeks of camp will receive a 10% discount on the basic camp fee if they register and pay the registration fees for all weeks registered for on or before June 17th, 2019.

Important Information for Campers

Campers should wear comfortable, modest, summer play clothes. Sometimes campers will need a change of clothes. Campers will need to pack a lunch each day unless otherwise directed.

What Will your camper do each day?

Each day between the hours of 9 am and 3 pm, campers have the opportunity to learn something new, exercise their creativity, invent, make new friends, and have tons of fun, all in a Christ-centered, loving environment. Each week includes Bible stories, field trips, and all kinds of projects and activities!
