



Philosophy & Goals

At WUMP, we believe that balanced growth is best achieved by encouraging development of the whole child. Emphasis is placed on meeting the child's physical, emotional, intellectual, and spiritual needs through the sharing of Christian values in a loving atmosphere of acceptance, trust, and structured freedom.

Each day the preschool provides the children with a safe, secure environment for fostering independence and self-awareness. Our curriculum is based on the belief that children "learn by doing". Each age group is provided with age-appropriate guidelines that challenge the child to explore, experiment with, and better understand the wonders of his/her world.

Our program is part of the education and outreach ministries of Warrenton United Methodist Church. The program is open to all children regardless of race, gender, color, or religious affiliation.

The Co-op Program

Our program at WUMP is a cooperative program. Each family is asked to volunteer one day in their child's classroom each month. This gives each teacher an opportunity to more fully provide individualized attention to each child. The parent volunteer will help with gentle guidance and general housekeeping. The parent helper is to provide that day's snack even if they cannot volunteer.

A Note About Our Staff

Teachers at WUMP are dedicated professionals who value children and are committed to providing each and every child the best early education possible. Every teacher is required to complete 8 hours of continuing education per year.

Love, understanding, and nurturing are the guideposts with which teachers outline lessons, develop classroom themes, and organize the class so that each child is made to feel safe and secure while being allowed to explore his/her world.

Enrollment Information

Children must be 3 years old by September 30th to enroll. Enrollment for the upcoming school year begins in February. Church members, currently enrolled students and siblings are given first priority. Registration is then opened to the community. Age, maturity, and prior preschool experience will determine placement in classes.

All children must be potty trained prior to the start of school.

There is a non-refundable registration fee. Payment of the fee and completion of the registration form guarantees your child a place in the program. Tuition is paid one month in advance. There is a tuition break for those families with more than one child enrolled.
